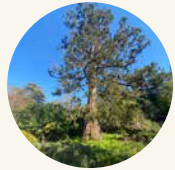

The **Giant Sequoia** was brought from Yosemite Valley as a small tree in the 1880s. Its rounded top and domed-over appearance is typically associated with thousand-year-old trees.



The **Rose Garden** is one of our notable specialty gardens with more than 150 varieties.



The **English Oak** commands a 63" diameter and is said to have been planted by George Worn in the 1880s.



A single Magnolia tree planted in the late 19th century grew into a magnificent ring of trees known as **Magnolia Circle**.
